

## Miley Cyrus Relates to 'Bolt' Dog

**Actress says she understands the need to “turn off” Hollywood persona.**

Miley Cyrus says she has a lot more in common with her cartoon costar Bolt than you'd think. In “Bolt,” a cartoon puppy is a TV action star who realizes he's just a regular dog with no real-life superpowers when he's off the Hollywood lot.

“I think it really shows a lot of kids when they see pictures of me in the press and the paparazzi where I'm not all glamorous and all done up,” Cyrus told MTV News. “You have to realize it's kind of like Bolt — that's what he has to learn to do.”
