In April 2007, MAF launched a global research effort to discover new and effective treatments for dogs who suffer from cancer as well as to fund the search for a cure. When you donate \$50, you'll receive a Canine Cancer Campaign pet tag that can be personally engraved with your dog's name, information, and special message (if desired). For each additional \$50 donation, you'll receive an engraved tag.
